IMPORTANT NOTICE

PASSENGER VEHICLE BODY CONSTRUCTION KS 372, IMPLEMENTATION

The Kenya Standard **KS 372**, for Passenger Vehicle Body Construction was developed by the Kenya Bureau of Standards (KEBS) and gazetted in 2014. This is to notify the Public that the commencement date for the implementation of KS 372 is **22nd May, 2017**.

From 22nd May, 2017;

- 1) All **NEW** and **SECOND HAND** passenger service vehicles are required to comply with the KS372 before **PRE-REGISTRATION INSPECTION**.
- 2) All passenger vehicle **BODY BUILDERS** are required to comply with KS372. Application and approval to be a body builder is on-going through the National Transport and Safety Authority website (www.nts.go.ke).
- 3) All **IMPORTED** passenger vehicles are required to comply with KS 372.
- 4) **ACCREDITATION** of organizations to carry out inspection activities as per the requirements of KS 372 by Kenya Accreditation Service (KENAS) is on-going.
